You are invited to join the annual Lenten School of Theology the first three Sundays in March from 6-8p @ St Stephen Lutheran Church (537 Bolton St, Marlborough). This year's topic is **God of Faith & Science**, an exploration of the relationships between faith & reason, religion & technology, God & creation. Each week we will be led through different topics by presenters who are leaders in each field:

- † Mar 7—God & the Wonders of the Universe – Rev. Dr. David Buehler
What does the expanse of the universe—planets, stars, galaxies—reveal about the God who brought all things into being?
- † Mar 14—God & the Care of Creation – Dr. Jessica Sutherland.
What is our responsibility to the creation—the stewardship of our environment and its resources—as beings made in the image of God?
- † Mar 21—God & the New Social Media – Rev. Keith Anderson
What role do emerging technologies—internet, Twitter, Facebook—play in the mission of the people of God?

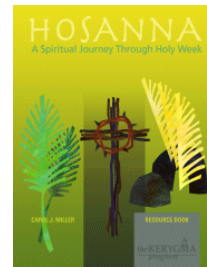
